

**Fallbrook United Methodist Church**  
**Undergraduate Scholarship Application Requirements**

**Please submit all materials for your completed application by April 28, 2023.**

(late applications for college will not be considered)

**Participation requests may be submitted throughout the 23-24 academic year.**

1. **ESSAY: 1st time applicant; Interview on April or May, 2023 will be required:** A signed essay of 300 words or more describing your personal background, school, church activities, awards, work experience, community service, college plans, how your major will lead to your career goals, and your faith statement of how God is working in your life.

**2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year applicants:** Provide an update of your spiritual, educational and career experiences and goals since last year. Include your campus and community activities.

**Participation Requests:** High School or College students may request funds to support activities like camps, teams, supplies, registration, competitions, etc. to participate in activities that will enhance their respective major. This can be separate from tuition requests. Please give specific details about the activity and how it will help you.

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2. **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:**

**1st year applicant** requires **two** letters from a faculty member, counselor and/or administrator and **one** letter from an adult in the church or community who knows you well.

**2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year applicants** require **one** letter from your college professor, counselor or administrator. Additional letters may be from your community service involvement. Letters **MUST** be on **school or agency letterhead** with original signatures.

3. **TRANSCRIPTS: 1<sup>st</sup> year applicant** requires high school transcript with official seal through first semester of your senior year.  
**2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year applicants** may submit paper copies of your college grades or transcript from the previous fall semester/quarter.
4. **COLLEGE LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE: 1<sup>st</sup> year applicant or transfer student** must provide a copy of the official college letterhead notification of acceptance.
5. **TEACHER/COUNSELOR/LETTER FOR EVENT PARTICIPATION:** Requests for fees related to your major, and a description of the activity, and how it relates to your major.

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- Fallbrook United Methodist Church Scholarships are awarded for **UNDERGRADUATE** education up to a total of **FOUR** years.
  - Scholarship applications may also be submitted for participation in activities related to your major or community service, including fees, materials, etc. and can be requested, as needed.
  - Selection is based on academic achievement, active participation in your church, school or community, including Youth Group, community service events and leadership roles, plus good recommendations and favorable impressions from your interview with the Scholarship Committee.
  - Financial need, highly motivated educational and career goals, service to others and Christian values are considered.
  - Scholarship amounts vary depending upon the number of scholarships awarded, identified needs and monies available each year.
